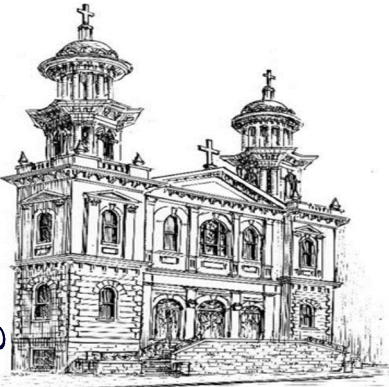

SEWER REBATE PROGRAM--If you are a City of Reno or Sparks resident, a property owner or renter, **and** you are receiving benefits from:

The Nevada State Welfare Division Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEA)

Social Security Income (SSD) due to a disability

Supplemental Social Security Income (SSSI)

Veterans Administration Disability (VA) benefits due to a disability

You may also be eligible for a sewer rebate from the City of Sparks or Reno. Obtain the City of Reno application online: www.reno.gov, in person at Reno City Hall or by calling 334-2365.

Sparks residents, call 353-5555, or pick up an application at Sparks City Hall.

APPLICATIONS MUST BE SUBMITTED BY AUGUST 31, 2017.

Funds will be disbursed on a first come/first serve basis.

The rebate will be issued to eligible applicants who apply between 7/1/17—8/31/17.

Applications received after August 31, 2017 will not be eligible.
