CBS will be offered on **Thursday** nights, beginning in September, 6-8 PM at 3 different sites:

**Our Lady of the Snows Parish Center, Reno. St Patrick's, Fallon. St Joseph's Elko.**

**Annual Cost:** \$550 per person plus books.

There will be one Saturday session in Reno, August 25, 9:30 AM --12:30 PM. Our teacher, Gene Giuliano from the University of Dallas, will come to Reno to introduce the program to participants and talk about the Bible from the Catholic perspective. (This session will be taped for registrants who cannot make it that day.)
